Under the REDRH project, the physical progress reporting of house construction is entered from the District level in the MIS (www.sikkimrmdd.gov.in). This data forms the basis of the Monthly Progress Report which facilitates performance assessment. As on 31<sup>st</sup> January 2015, the top five Blocks in terms of physical progress (based on MIS) are Namchi, Jorethang, Melli, Hee Bermiok and Duga, while the under-performing Blocks are Passingdang, Mangan, Soreng, Ravongla and Daramdin. The detailed MPR prepared block wise is enclosed.

The status of Stock Material Supply as on 31<sup>st</sup> January 2015 has been compiled by RMDD head office and is enclosed. **The status of stock material supply by STCS and SIMFED** is as follows. Of the total 13.87 lakh bags of cement indented, 12.74 lakh bags of cement (92%) have been supplied till date. Also of the total 12659.13 MT of TMT bars indented, 12314.67 MT (97%) has been supplied till date.
